Selling the raised animal or its in-high-demand milk, or to use it for farming, allows them to become self-sufficient, giving them basic knowledge about farming and raising of the animals."

In India, children play a big part in the process of raising animals for food and planting seeds for crops. For children in India, long hours in the field dominate their time.

Education
