

ITINERARY

DAY 1: Sun., April 8 - Depart from New York

Depart for your international flight to Tel Aviv.

DAY 2: Mon., April 9 - Tel Aviv/Jerusalem

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv, you will be assisted and transferred to your hotel in Jerusalem. En route to the hotel enjoy a visit to the Biblical gardens at Neot Kedumim and an orientation tour of Jerusalem

Jerusalem - The eternal city of faith is the home of three of the world's major religions: Christianity, Judaism, and Islam. It is the city of the Temple of David and Solomon, and the site of Christ's passion. Travelers through the Old City find a dazzling array of shops, marketplaces, monuments, minarets, shrines, and people of all nationalities.

Dinner: Enjoy a Welcome Dinner at the hotel.

DAY 3: Tues., April 10 - Jerusalem/Bethlehem/Jerusalem

AM: City Sightseeing

After breakfast enjoy a panoramic view of this ancient city from the Mt. of Olives. As you look across the Temple Mount with the Mosque of the Dome of the Rock in the foreground, the old city is spread out like a map below. Visit the Place of the Ascension, Pater Noster, Dominus Flevit, the Tomb of the Virgin, and the Basilica of the Agony in the Garden of Gethsemene.

PM: Visit to Bethlehem

In the afternoon you will travel to Bethlehem, city of David, and the birthplace of Christ. Visit the oldest Christian church in the Holy Land, Church of the Nativity, which stands over the Manger Cave. It has withstood fire, and the ravages of time, as it protects the spot where Jesus was born. You will also visit St. Catherine's Church. There will be some time for shopping before you return to Jerusalem.

Dinner: Enjoy dinner at the hotel.

DAY 4: Wed., April 11 - Jerusalem

AM: Sightseeing Tour of the Old City

After a full Israeli breakfast, you will proceed to the Old City and enter through St. Stephen's Gate. Visit the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed the lame man and St. Anne's Church, the birthplace of the Virgin Mary. Walk the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher where you will visit Calvary and the Tomb.

Proceed to Mt. Zion and the room of the Last Supper. You also visit David's Tomb, Dormition Abbey, and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu.

Dinner: Enjoy dinner at the hotel.

DAY 5: Thurs., April 12 - Jerusalem

AM: Sightseeing Tour

After breakfast, visit the Temple Mount and the Western Wall, all that is left of the complex destroyed by the Roman General Titus in 70 AD. See a model of First Century Jerusalem. Visit Ein Karem to see the Church of St. John the Baptist and the Basilica of the Visitation.

Dinner: Enjoy dinner at the hotel.

DAY 6: Fri., April 13 - Jerusalem

Enjoy a full day at leisure to relax or join the optional tour to Masada and the lowest point on Earth, the Dead Sea.

Dinner: Enjoy dinner at the hotel.

DAY 7: Sat., April 14 - Jerusalem/Jordan Valley/Nazareth/Tiberias

Depart Jerusalem after breakfast and continue to Jericho via the Judean Desert and the Inn of the Good Samaritan. Continue through the Jordan Valley to Nazareth and visit the Basilica of the Annunciation and the Church of St. Joseph.

Stop in Nazareth where the Galilee of Jesus has been recreated. Visit the Church of the Wedding in Cana of Galilee before arriving in Tiberias.

Tiberias - A hillside resort city that overlooks the Sea of Galilee. This entire area is rich with religious and historical interests.

Dinner: Enjoy dinner at the hotel.



DAY 8: Sun., April 15 - Tiberias/Capernaum/Tiberias

Sail across the Sea of Galilee to Genneseret. Visit Capernaum, the town of Jesus. See the Ancient Synagogue and the site of St. Peter's house. Visit the Church of the Primacy and the Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes at the Mount of Beatitudes.

Capernaum - In the time of Christ this was a border town on the main route from Damascus to the sea coast and Egypt. Capernaum became the second home of Jesus, to which He always returned.

Ascend Mt. Tabor, the Mount of Transfiguration. Visit the Jordan River Baptismal Site. Return to your hotel in Tiberias.

Dinner: Enjoy dinner at the hotel.

DAY 9: Mon., April 16 - Tiberias/Haifa/Caesarea/Tel Aviv

Depart Tiberias, and travel along the Mediterranean coast to Mt. Carmel. Visit the Shrine of St. Elijah at Mukhraka. Proceed through the city of Haifa and visit the Shrine of Stella Maris, the mother Church of the Carmelite order. Continue south to Caesarea, the intriguing Roman city of Herod where St. Paul was imprisoned and Peter baptized the Roman centurion Cornelius, the first gentile convert to Christianity. View the remains of the amphitheater and the Aqueduct. Continue to Tel Aviv and visit St. Peter's Church in Old Jaffa.

Tel Aviv - Hub of Israel's commerce, this modern city is situated on the Mediterranean. It has long stretches of ivory coast and blue, sun-kissed skies.

Dinner: Enjoy a delicious Farewell Dinner at the hotel.

After dinner you will be transferred to the airport for your return flight home.

DAY 10: Tues., April 17 - Tel Aviv/New York

AM: You return home richly endowed with new insights, spiritual renewal, and vast cultural wealth.

A deposit (by check) of \$1000 p/person is required at time of registration, along with a signed registration form. A second deposit of \$1000 p/person (by check) is due on or before October 8, 2017. You will be billed for the balance, which is due on or before December 8, 2017 either by check or money order. All registrations received after December 8, 2017 must be accompanied by full payment.

CANCELLATION TERMS:

Cancellations received:

Prior to Dec. 8, 2017: \$200 p/person
From Dec.8-Dec. 31, 2017: \$500 p/person
From Jan. 1-Jan. 31, 2018: \$1000 p/person
From Feb. 1, 2018 onward: No refund
All cancellations must be received in writing.

NOTE: Comprehensive insurance is available to cover trip cancellation and interruption, baggage protection, medical, accidental death & dismemberment and emergency evacuation and repatriation. A descriptive booklet will be mailed to you upon receipt of your deposit.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Economy class via any regular IATA carrier. Any cancellation, itinerary change or failure to use confirmed air space may be subject to penalties levied by the airlines at the time of ticketing. **Air tickets, once issued, are non-refundable. This is in addition to above "Cancellation Terms."**

PASSPORT/VISA REQUIREMENTS: A valid passport is required for all tour members. U.S. citizens do not require visas for travel to Israel. If you are not a U.S. citizen call the Consulate of EVERY country you will enter (even in-transit when changing planes) to check on visa requirements. ALL passports must be valid for at least 6 months after the return date of the tour.

TOUR PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE: Passport, visa, and insurance, All items of a personal nature, beverages and meals not included in the tour. Gratuities to guides, bus drivers, tour escort, and hotel and restaurant staff. Optional tours and excess baggage charges.
